Should your train schedule necessitate arriving the day before, don't worry—your extra night will be covered!





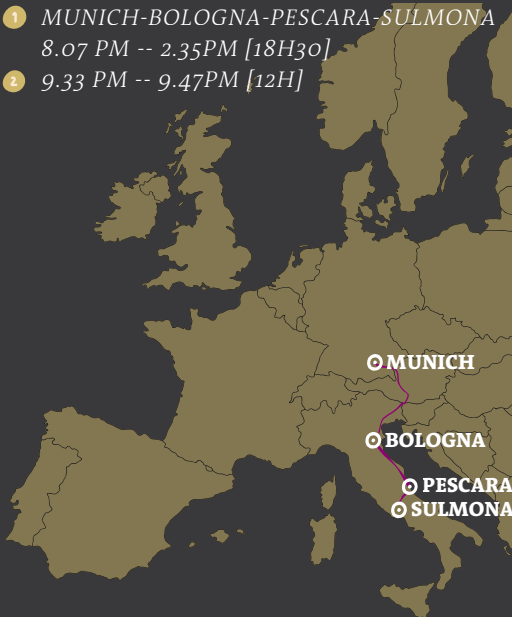

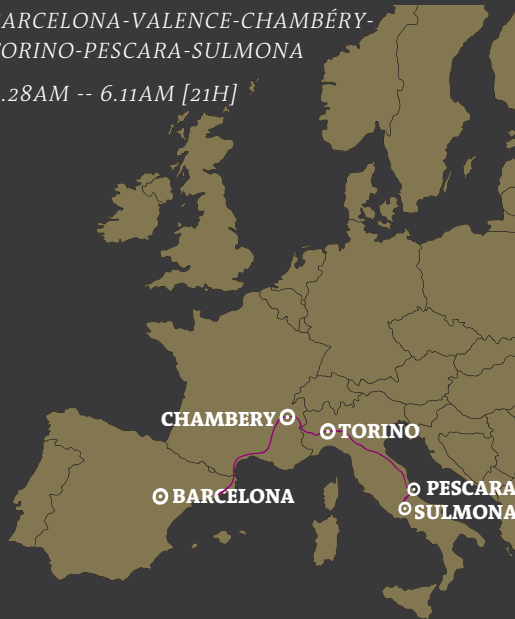
