Field actions

Building an electric fence, monitoring wildlife... we directly contribute to the NGO actions!

Immersion in nature

Throughout the week, we navigate through the different ecosystems of our landscape, discovering its non-human inhabitants!

Meeting with local producers

People are at the heart of our actions and we want you to meet the ones who believe in our values!
